State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV); model transition IEP; report.

Bill Status

House Floor

Key Points

- Requires SCHEV and the Dept. of Education to develop a model transition IEP to help facilitate the provision of transition services and accommodations for students with disabilities by public institutions of higher education.
- Requires SCHEV to encourage private institutions to accept the model transition IEP.
- This legislation is a follow-up to SCHEV's [November 2025 report](#) on barriers to transition.

Impact on Virginians

The use of a model transition IEP will help students with disabilities and families to understand the transition process and better prepare for life after high-school. In addition, a model transition IEP will help to ensure that institutions of higher education are provided with the necessary information to provide appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities.
